


Mural painting by Carlos Magano at FEUSP - The march of human knowledge - 1956

RESEARCH

Research activity at the University of São Paulo is inherent to the work of teachers, as well as training for the students research since undergraduation. At FEUSP students and professors are encouraged and widely strengthened to research through institutional programs by USP and by the School itself, as well as by the diffusion of notices for national and international funding agencies to support the development of projects, cores and groups of faculty research. Programs of Introduction to Scientific Research (for Undergraduate Program students) and Pre-Introduction to Scientific Research (for High School students) aim to arouse and stimulate interest in research activity, according to the different scientific fields of the School of Education. The student can develop its own project of Introduction to Scientific Research with a scholarship offered by the funding agencies. The International Symposium of Introduction to Scientific Research USP (SIICUSP) is organized annually by the Research Commission, in cooperation with other units and the Pro-Rector of research at USP. It is worth noting the annual publication of the IC Series FEUSP with the production of the students after finishing their projects.

The Post-doctoral internships promoted at USP are also included in the School's research, with the goal of improving their scientific excellence. Researchers from different universities of the country take part in the Post-doctoral Program. This students and the Research Commission annually promote the Post-doctoral Seminar of FEUSP.
