USP and FEUSP maintain a wide array of institutional agreements with colleges and universities located in Asia, Africa, Latin America, North America, Middle East and Europe. Such agreements comprise all areas of enquiry, offering a wide range of study and research possibilities.

Current students may attend courses abroad up to one semester. Faculty members may choose between short-term staying, split-site PhD program or postdoctoral research. Staff members, in turn, may apply to short-term activities aimed at professional growth and development. Students, faculty members as well as staff members may apply to any of our partner international institutions.

Exchange students

1. Application

Foreign students who wish to apply for an exchange program from the School of Education (CRInt- FEUSP) must follow the deadlines below:

First semester (From Jan until Jul): online application until October 5th. Register must be conducted by the Home University)

Second semester (From Aug until Dec): online application until May 5th. Register must be conducted by the Home University.

Applicants should send all required documentation via email as well as mail the original documents. Acceptance letters will be sent to the applicant's home institution within 20 days after receipt of all originals. Undergraduate students may apply to up to 5 courses per semester in their area of interest. Graduate students, in turn, may apply to up to 3 courses per semester.
