


Mural painting by Carlos Magano at FEUSP - The march of human knowledge - 1956

GRADUATE PROGRAM

The Graduate Program, stricto sensu, at the School of Education began in 1971. In 2016 it has 565 regular students (357 doctorates and 208 masters), and 117 registred professors. In 2016, approximately 69 theses and 83 dissertations were defended in this Graduate Program.

Also in 2016, 122 scholarships were granted by several research support agencies, among them CAPES (62), FAPESP (34), and CNPq (26). It is listed among the best programs in Brazil, according to the CAPES Assessment Index. It has two complementary goals:

- to develop research and to prepare researchers for the education field, including themes related to teaching systems and their several levels and modalities, and the multiple social spheres in which education is present;
 - to prepare researchers-professors for College Education.
- 10 Research Lines are part of the Graduate Program at the School of Education: Culture, Organization and Education; Didactics, Teaching Theories and School Practices; Special Education; Teaching of Sciences and Mathematics; State, Society and Education; Philosophy of Education; History of Education and Historiography; Language and Education; Psychology and Education; and Sociology and Education.
