

THE SCHOOL OF EDUCATION

The School of Education (FE) grants professional degrees in teaching for 27 curricular fields from 10 different USP academic programs. It also provides different development programs for undergraduate students, such as the Introduction to Scientific Research in Education and extension courses.

Moreover, the School offers continuing education programs through courses, symposiums, and research and extension projects for different professionals in the field of Education – school teachers, assistants and managers – in order to foster the development of new professional profiles that combine research and contemporary educational demands.

FE offers undergraduate and graduate programs (master’s and doctorate degrees), as well as several research modalities and academic extension programs.

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE IN EDUCATION

To obtain the degree in Pedagogy, the student must complete 3,240 course hours, which comprise: 34 mandatory courses and 09 free electives, 420 mandatory internship hours, 200 independent study hours and an optional 180 hour Final Essay, all to be earned in a period of 4 to 6 years of study. Every year 180 new students join the course – 60 in the daytime classes and 120 in the evening classes.

The Career in Pedagogy

Teaching

- Early Childhood and Primary/Elementary Education in public and private educational institutions.

Management

- School Principal and Assistant Principal (Vice-Principal) in elementary, middle and high schools in public and private educational institutions;
- Education Coordinator in different levels and modalities in primary/elementar, middle and high schools;
- School Counselor in different levels and modalities in primary/elementary school;
- Teaching Practice Supervisor in public schools, both in the state and in the municipal sector;
- Education Practitioner certified for educational planning, execution, coordination, assistance and assessment.

Consulting

- Education consultant in a broad range of civil society organizations;
- Education consultant in other fields where pedagogic knowledge is required;
- Education specialist in educational planning, execution, coordination, assistance and assessment of nonschool educational experiences and projects;
- Education specialist in production, research and diffusion of academic knowledge in Education in school and nonschool educational settings.

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE IN TEACHING

The School of Education offers pedagogical content courses for the following undergraduate teaching programs at USP: Portuguese, Spanish, English, German, French, Italian, Greek, Eastern Languages, Linguistics, History, Geography, Geology, Social Sciences, Philosophy, Geosciences and Environmental Education, Mathematics, Biological Sciences, Physics, Chemistry, Physical Education, Psychology, Nursing, Drama, Visual Arts, Music and Educommunication.

The teaching career

Licensed teachers find work in middle and high schools as teachers of their certified area of study, as well as in scientific research.

THE SCHOOL OF APPLICATION

The School of Application (Escola de Aplicação – EAFEUSP) is affiliated to the School of Education and is committed to providing public, free and quality education to primary, middle and high school students, as well as being a reference in teaching development beyond the University walls. Therefore, the School students are usually involved in knowledge production and research projects. The experience happens during the students’ regular classes, in field studies (Environment and Field Study trips) and throughout after-school activities involving preintroduction to scientific research, curriculum enrichment activities, Olympiads in different fields of study, academic events and so on.

The School of Application aims to foster research, teaching and extension activities within elementary, middle and high school education. Thus, EAFEUSP develops and receives research projects from the distinct University colleges and institutes, besides collaborating with other academic institutions. In this regard, the school welcomes intern students from the different courses at USP, contributing to the development of undergraduate students and broadening the opportunities to rethink and reinvent teaching practices.

THE LIBRARY

The School of Education Library is specialized in Education and has one of the country’s richest and most comprehensive collections in Education. It includes books, dissertations, journals and media that are relevant to the curricula at FEUSP as well as to related subjects. The consultation of collections and the use of services are not restricted to the FEUSP community. They reach a wider community, especially researchers from all over Brazil, attracted by the diversity, historical richness and updating of its collections.
