(34 mandatory courses + 9 and free elective courses + 420 internship hours + 200 hours Cientific and Cultural Academic Activities + optative Final Essay)

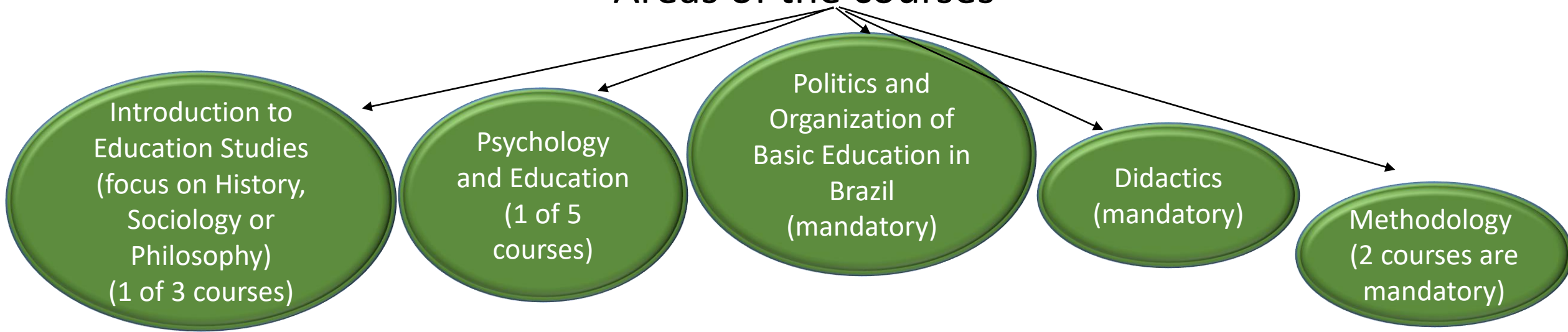
